Are you an experienced Early Years practitioner, or new to the profession? Do you want to consolidate your maths subject knowledge and pedagogy? Or do you want to embed excellent practice into your maths teaching, and support colleagues to do the same?

The Maths Hubs' programmes for 2019/20 have something for everyone. Collaborative, locally based Work Groups support those who want to work with others to develop their own practice and knowledge. National leadership programmes also provide a chance to gain recognised qualifications and develop the skills of others. All Maths Hubs opportunities are free to join and funding is often available to offset the cost of cover.

Want an improvement in whole school maths teaching?

The national project for 2019/20 focuses on **Supporting effective transition from Reception to Year 1**. Participants in Work Groups will explore how good practice in the early learning of maths can feed into teaching for mastery at KS1.

Want to become a more effective and knowledgeable practitioner?

Practitioners, teachers and teaching assistants who want to develop their subject knowledge and pedagogy in maths teaching can take part in a **Subject Knowledge for Teaching Mathematics (SKTM)** programme. Participants will access newly-developed resources and benefit from expert input.

Want to become a leader of maths-specific professional development?

Experienced Early Years practitioners can become nationally recognised Professional Development Leads. Through the **NCETM PD Lead Programme**, participants develop, run and evaluate a programme of professional development for colleagues, leading to accreditation as a PD Lead.
