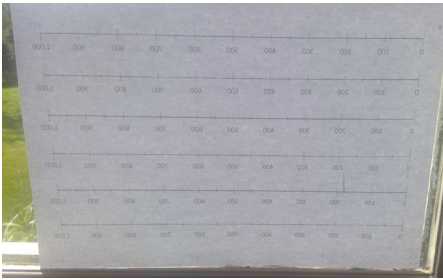


Making the laminated number lines

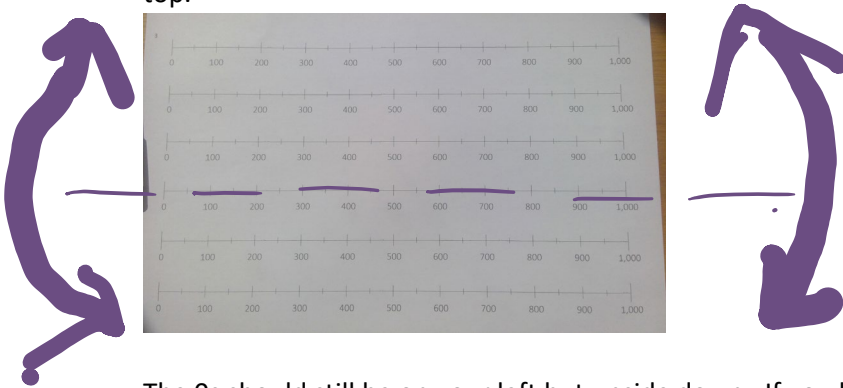
1. Copy your master sheet so you have 6 sheets (36 number lines) – single sided at this point
2. Hold up each sheet to a window like this:



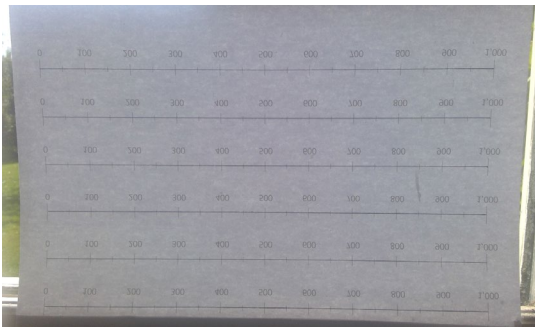
3. Draw over the **number line** and **end markers** only. Do not mark any other points or any numbers. When you take your sheet off the window it should look like this



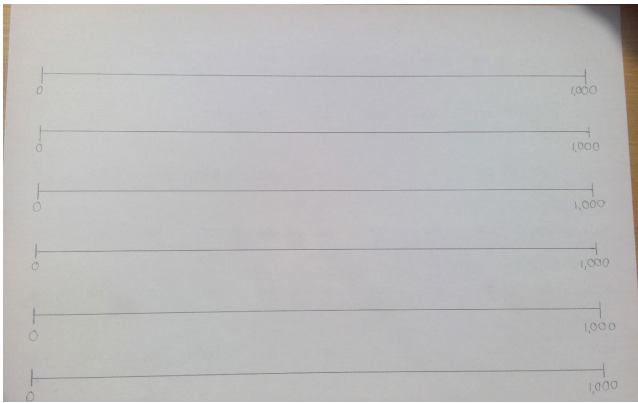
4. Hold the front of your sheet facing you like this and flip it as shown, rotating around the horizontal line in the middle so the top of the sheet is at the bottom and the bottom is at the top.



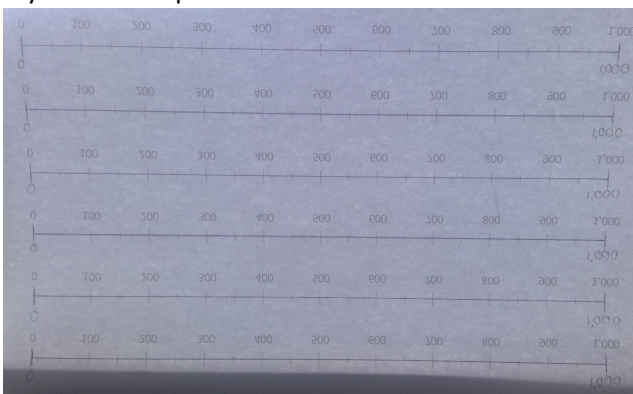
The 0s should still be on your left but upside down. If you hold it up on a window it should look like this. **CHECK CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU START WRITING NUMBERS AS IT IS EASY TO GO WRONG AND ANNOYING TO HAVE TO START AGAIN**



5. Mark the 0 and the end number ONLY under each line (don't use too heavy a pen as it will show through – handwriting pen is perfect). The finished sheet should look like this.



If you hold it up to the window it should look like this with all the 0s at the same end.



6. Laminate, cut into strips, and put a loom band on each strip to get your finished number lines.
